Ipswich UC Ministry Team

Rev David Fender commenced supply ministry part-time (0.5) on Monday 1st August and Ps Brett Scherer will commence supply ministry part-time (0.8) on Thursday 1st September. These supply ministries are in addition to Ps Nyleta Bruce (0.2), Ps Sarah Rothery (0.2), and Rev Peter Arnett in a full-time ministry placement.

Volunteering Opportunity - NewLife Op Shop

NewLife Op Shop has great potential to increase its operations, but is limited by currently available staff. Currently the shop only opens two days per week (Tuesday and Thursday). The initial desire is to increase to three days (Tues-Wed-Thurs) and ultimately 5 or 6 days per week.

The limiting factor is volunteers to operate the shop. Roles are available in the back room (receiving, sorting, pricing donations), and in the shop front. One important role in the shop front is Pastoral Care as the shop presents an opportunity for the church to engage with the community. We will not extend shop hours unless we feel the pastoral care is adequately resourced.
